Innovation in Science Pursuit for Inspired Research (INSPIRE) Scheme INSPIRE Fellowship

(A component under INSPIRE)

<u>Call for Applications under INSPIRE Fellowship</u> (2021)

Department of Science & Technology (DST) has taken several pioneering initiatives for attracting meritorious students to study basic and natural sciences at the college and university level and to pursue research careers in both basic and applied science areas including engineering, medicine, agriculture and veterinary sciences through various components under INSPIRE.

Innovation in Scientific Pursuit for Inspired Research (INSPIRE), offers standing opportunity for pursuing Doctoral Research at any recognized University or Institute in India through Fellowships at same level as National Eligibility Test (NET) qualified candidates. INSPIRE Fellowship component of INSPIRE Programme is focused on attraction of students to pursue regular doctoral degree in basic and applied sciences including engineering, medicine, agriculture, veterinary, pharmacy etc. after either Masters' degree in Science/ Applied Science/ Engineering or Bachelors'/ Masters' degree in Medicine.

Applications are invited for the year 2021, from eligible candidates within the age group 22-27 years for Fellowship under INSPIRE Fellowship component of INSPIRE scheme of DST through the web-portal https://www.online-inspire.gov.in

Eligibility:

 (a) INSPIRE Scholar having secured minimum 70% marks (or CGPA equivalent) in aggregate at M.Sc. or Integrated M.S./ M.Sc.

(or)

(b) 1st Rank Holder at University level examination in Post-Graduate (PG) level examinations in Basic/Applied Sciences including Engineering, Pharmacy, Agricultural sciences and Veterinary Sciences from any recognized University and academic Institutions (Excluding Autonomous Colleges) in India.

(or)

(c) 1st Rank Holder at University level examination in Graduate/Post-graduate Degree in Medicine only from any recognized Indian University or Institute/Statutory Body in India.

Please Note that Students who i) are 1st Rank Holder in College including Autonomous College Examination, ii) have obtained degree (s) through Distance Education Mode and iii) are 1st Rank Holder in any specialization given at M.Sc. 2nd/ last year, are not eligible for the offer of INSPIRE Fellowship.

Candidates who are Indian Citizens and have acquired their eligibility for INSPIRE Fellowship during the years 2020 and 2021 are eligible to apply.

The students who are already enjoying Senior Research Fellowship (SRF) or higher position in any project or **otherwise** are not eligible to apply for this. <u>Merely having the eligibility does not guarantee the offer of</u> <u>INSPIRE Fellowship</u>. Finally, selected students for INSPIRE Fellowship against the previous advertisement need not to apply again.

Emoluments: The Fellowship amount under INSPIRE Fellowship is as per GoI norms of fellowship (*Junior Research Fellowship*/ Senior Research Fellowship) and research grant to the candidate. There is a provision of 1000 INSPIRE Fellowships to be offered to eligible students against the INSPIRE Fellowship-2021 call and each Fellowship is tenable for a **maximum period of five years** or completion of the PhD degree, whichever is earlier. This Fellowship shall not be available to pursue M.Sc. or M.Phil. or M. Tech. course while pursing Integrated M.Sc.-Ph.D./ M. Phil.-Ph.D./ M. Tech.-Ph.D. courses.

How to apply: Interested and eligible students must apply and submit their application with allessential documents through **ONLINE** mode only. Applications are to be submitted online on INSPIRE web-portal https://www.online-inspire.gov.in. Those interested in submitting application have to register at this portal

and submit the application online. Please read guidelines available on the portal carefully before submitting the application. This web- portal will be open from 1st March 2022 to 31st March 2022 (till 23:59 hrs. IST) for submission of applications.
